NOTE: It is important that applicants read and understand the AVSEC requirements before completing the form.

- 1. All applications must be approved by the General Manger AVSEC or in his absence the Head of Security or Manager ID Centre after Induction has been completed and signed off.
- 2. ID card is issued on **MONDAY** to **FRIDAY** each week between the hours of 0900 hours of am and 1500 pm.
- 3. Payment must be made to NAC ID Centre, Domestic Terminal, and Level 1.
- 4. Must be escorted by a red ASIC holder when access is required to the Security Restricted Area (SRA)
- 5. Must be displayed at the outer garment at chest height.
- 6. Use for official purposes only and is not transferable.
- 7. Payment of K250.00 per Contractor Pass.
- 8. If it's Lost, Stolen or damaged card(K50.00) read the terms and conditions
- 9. The Contractor Pass Remains the property of the National Airports Corporation and shall be removed ANYTIME without notice if the holder does not comply with requirements stated below.

Contractor Pass Guide

- 1. Issued Contractor Pass, remains the property of NAC and maybe withdrawn any time by the <u>Manager Aviation</u> <u>Security (AVSEC).</u>
- The Contractor Pass is issued to Contractors for use in the Security Restricted Area (SRA) and must be escorted by an authorized red ASIC card holder.
- 3. The Contractor Pass is issued for the performance of official duties and strictly business only.
- 4. The Contractor Pass is not transferable and shall be surrendered to the issuing authority upon completion of the task at the following locations.
 - a) the National ID Card Centre (Level 1 Domestic Terminal)
 - b) Airside Operations Office

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

- 5. The holder **shall comply** with any reasonable instruction given by an airport security officer or authorized officer of the civil aviation authority.
- 6. The Contractor Pass **shall be worn above the waist** on the outer garment at **all times** whilst on lawful duty, in the security restricted, prohibited or sterile areas.
- Unauthorized possession, use retention, alteration, destruction or transfer of Contractor Pass can attract penalty under CAA regulations.
- 8. Any person in possession of a Contractor Pass found unescorted airside in Security Restricted Area (SRA) will have the pass removed and is to leave the area immediately
- 9. Contractor Pass holder **shall immediately report** in writing the **loss** of his/her card/pass with state dec to the issuing authority.
- 10. Individuals, who continue to lose ID Passes, are advised that consideration will be given for denial of future ID pass issuance.
