Drainage System maintenance and improvement at Jacksons Airport

NAC is committed to continuous improvement and maintenance of the Port Moresby International Airport (Jacksons), as the main gateway to Papua New Guinea and its busiest hub connecting the other 21 regional airports.

Current maintenance and improvement work on the airport's drainage system is progressing smoothly.

The work involves reinstalling of stone pitched line drainage & existing head walls. The maintenance of the drainage system is important to maintain safety and compliance for daily aircraft movement upon taxing for take-off & after arrival.

Airports are flat areas and therefore needs rapid water absorption and an integrated drainage system to enable puddles and or standing water on the surface to immediately flow into the drains.

Inadequate drainage can lead to flooding, endangering air traffic, erosion, saturation and the weakening of pavements.
