IMPORTANT REMINDER TO APPROVED LANDSIDE VEHICLE PERMIT HOLDERS AT PORT MORESBY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The National Airports Corporation (NAC) would like to remind all Landside Vehicle Permit (LVP) holders, both those who are registered on the automated vehicle entry system **(digital)** and those with **vehicle sticker passes**, of the Terms and Conditions (T&Cs) associated with their permits.

To ensure a seamless experience for all passengers and visitors, NAC advise LVP holders to strictly observe the **2-minute time limit** for pick up and drop off and refrain from parking in front of the terminal, longer than the allowable limit.

NAC encourages permit holders to follow the LVP process as failure to comply may result in the following actions taken against them;

•Deregistration and access removal from the Automated Vehicle Entry System: You will be denied entry to the curbside.

•Vehicle Impoundment: Vehicles breaching the LVP T&Cs will be towed and impounded by the NAC.

• LVP Seizure: The LVP sticker will be confiscated or removed from the vehicle.

• Impounding Fee: A fee of K500 will be charged before the release of the impounded vehicle.

•Impact on Future LVP Applications: These breaches may affect the organization's eligibility for future LVP applications.

These access control measures are in line with the **PNG Civil Aviation Rules and NAC's Standard Operating Procedures** and are enforced to protect the airport from threats and any unlawful interferences.
