Gurney Airport – Restrictions on Aerodrome Operations

The National Airports Corporation (NAC) wishes to inform the travelling public and stakeholders that temporary restrictions will be in place at Gurney Airport over the coming weeks to allow for essential maintenance and upgrade works on the airside.

Key Dates and Restrictions:

1. Main Taxiway Closure

Duration: 48 hours

Dates: 21 September 2025 (12 noon) – 23 September 2025 (12 noon)

Impact: During this time, only helicopters will be able to operate. Fixed-wing aircraft will not be permitted.

2. Main Apron – Parking Bay 2 Closure

Duration: 7 days

Dates: 1 October 2025 – 7 October 2025

Impact: Parking Bay 2, will be closed. Only Bay 1 will remain available.

3. Main Apron – Parking Bay 1 Closure

Duration: 7 days

Dates: 8 October 2025 – 14 October 2025

Impact: Parking Bay 1, will be closed. Bays 2, 3, and 4 will remain available.

Please note that the timing of these works is subject to prevailing weather conditions. Any changes to the schedule will be communicated accordingly.

NAC remains firmly committed to the safety of passengers and aircraft operations at Gurney Airport. Working with the NAC-CADIP team, the Contractor will take every measure to minimize delays so that the upgrades progress quickly while maintaining the highest standards of quality.

These essential airside improvements are not only necessary for current operations but are also vital to enhancing the long-term safety, reliability, and service of Gurney Airport.

We apologize for any inconvenience these temporary restrictions may cause and thank the travelling public, operators, and the community for their understanding and cooperation.
