NAC opens Tokua Airport to A220 and introduces night flights at selected airports to support passenger movement during peak period

The National Airports Corporation (NAC) wishes to inform the traveling public, airline operators and all key stakeholders that the Tokua Airport will accommodate Airbus A220 aircraft operations on a temporary concession basis to help address peak period passenger demand.

This arrangement will commence on 16th December 2025 providing additional capacity during the busy festive season.

In addition, NAC is able to facilitate temporary night flight operations at Nadzab, Wewak, Momote and Kavieng airports, however this shall only be considered with advance notice from the airlines.

While night flight operations, fall outside of NAC's normal operating hours and place an additional burden on NAC's resources, they are being facilitated to ease congestion and improve passenger movement during the peak period.

NAC sincerely thanks all stakeholders including the traveling public, for their patience, cooperation and understanding during this period. We acknowledge the inconvenience experienced and offer our apologies to the affected passengers.
